This is in response to a national initiative by the Department for International Development and similar activities are taking place in other regions and countries of the UK.

The YHGSA employs a Co-ordinator who reports to the YHGSA Board. A number of working groups carry out a range of activities in agreement with the overall objectives established by the DFID. The Association is registered at Companies House as a limited charitable company and has a constitution based on a model supplied by the Charity Commission.
