

## Agenda 21 Bingo

### Aims

You can play this game either at the beginning of the topic, as an introduction to the various issues covered, or at the end, as a summary.

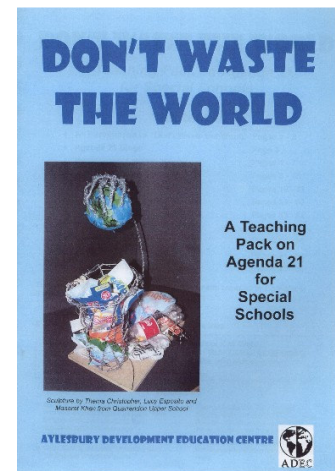
### You Will Need

Sheets of A4 paper.

Counters (16 per player or pair)

### Instructions

1. The pupils can play the game either individually or in pairs.
2. Each player splits their page into 16 boxes and randomly labels each box with the letters A – P. Make sure that they don't write the letters in order. The game will only work properly if each player has a differently arranged sheet. *You can always prepare these sheets in advance if you wish.*
3. Read out the following questions (they can be asked in any order). If the player can answer 'yes' to a question they place a counter on the corresponding letter on their sheet. When a player has got 4 counters in a row (horizontally, vertically or diagonally) they can shout 'Bingo!'. You don't need to stop when one player shouts 'Bingo!' – continue playing until all the questions have been asked.



### Questions:

- A Have you ever put something for recycling?
- B Do you usually turn the light switch off when you leave an empty room?
- C Do you usually have a shower rather than a bath?
- D Have you ever eaten a fair trade chocolate bar?
- E Do you walk to school?
- F Have you ever reused an old envelope?
- G Have you got a water butt in your garden?
- H Can you name one material that can be recycled?
- I Do you turn the tap off while you brush your teeth?
- J Have you seen a landfill site?
- K Have you got a draught excluder in your home?
- L Have you ever reused a plastic bag?
- M Have you ever eaten a fair trade banana?
- N Have you got a compost bin in your garden?
- O Have you ever taken something that you no longer want to a charity shop?
- P Can you name one thing that could be put in a compost bin?
